Training Pack

We decided that:

- The pack should contain a 15 minute session which would be the bare minimum expected of schools/ colleges. This would be timed to fit in with an assembly.
- The 15 minute presentation would include a powerpoint presentation, and road safety adverts from Ireland/Australia if possible.
- The pack would also contain enough material to run an hour long lesson.
- We would include some statistics, maps etc as trainers notes.
- We could include the 'Top 10 ways to lose your license' from the Community Wheels Project.
- We could produce our own Top Tips for Passengers sheet as a handout for every student.
- We would like to include a variety of road safety adverts from different countries as we feel this would stimulate a lot of discussion.
- We would like the power point to contain some of the shocking pictures David has showed us.
- We would also like to include information if schools/ colleges wanted to develop a project around the topic e.g. posters, dvd etc. Andrea talked about a dvd that was made in Epping that would be a good example.

- We decided that one of the days in the Summer we could do with getting the people who will be delivering the workshops to meet with us. David said he had found a case history where the involved parties were willing to participate in a project.
- We will also create our publicity that will go to schools and colleges.
- We will spend time drawing up the pack.
- We will draw up a firmer outline of the event.
